

# Glossary

<i>gold standard</i>	a data set that were annotated manually by human that can be used to evaluate the performance of automatic system to mimic human behavior of doing a specific task
<i>semantic</i>	the meanings of words and phrases
<i>semantic similarity</i>	a metric defined over a set of units of language (word, concept, sentence, etc.) to measure the likeness of their meaning
<i>lexical</i>	words referring to things, rather than only the grammatical meaning of it
<i>text corpus</i>	large and structured set of texts
<i>WordNet</i>	a machine-readable lexical database organized by meanings; developed at Princeton University
<i>word sense</i>	the meaning of a word
<i>synset</i>	synonym set; a set of words that can be used interchangeably in some context without changing its meaning
<i>sense</i>	one of the meanings of a word
<i>polysemous</i>	having more than one sense in a syntactic category
<i>POS</i>	part of speech; a category (noun, verb, etc.) of word according to its syntactic function.
