

ABSTRACT

Marriage is a human nature. In Islamic religion marriage is also a thing that can perfect one's religion. A marriage closely related to the readiness of age and reliability of the material. Great responsibility is one of the most important marriage grounds. Students who married at the time of study would still need a lot of consideration. This research focuses on the motives of married couples during the study period and how interpersonal communication is done by married couples who are married at young age.
