## TERMINOLOGY

- 0-Pick : When the order picker has to pick a product before the replenishment crew had the time to replenish it.
- Forward Area: Forward area, also called fast-pick area, is used for piece picking, while bulk or mass storage takes place in the reserve area.
- Reserve Area: The reserve area, also called bulk reserve, is used for storing the products. Later, these products will be replenished into the forward area.
- SKU: Stock Keeping Units, an identification component of a product
- Warehouse: A place assigned to store material to be used in the production process until the goods were asked based on the production.
