

ABSTRACT

PBO (Project Based Organization) is one of the ways of an organization to increase business values and benefits. Organizations are challenged to continue to improve project management performance through management process capabilities. In other words, applying measurement of management maturity is needed to explore the factors that determine project performance. PT PQR is a project-oriented public sector company in its work. Currently it is important for PT PQR to know the achievements of its project management. Therefore, the research was conducted to identify the level of maturity of the current project management implementation in the procurement area. This study uses Project Management Maturity Model (PMMM) as a framework used to design research instruments in the form of Self-Assessment Survey. Designing Self-Assessment Survey is done by first determining the criteria of assessment of the procurement process. The research was conducted through interviews using Self-Assessment Survey, then collecting evidence data to support the assessment. The results of the research are in the form of the level of maturity in the procurement process. From the research it was found that the level of maturity in the plan procurement management process is at level 3, the conduct procurement process is at level 5, while the procurement control process is at level 3. Overall shows that the process of PT PQR's procurement management project is currently located at level 3, which is related to standards and process management in the organization.
