NEW DESIGN PLANING BANDUNG HYBRID LIBRARY

Hybrid libraries or often called hybrid libraries are libraries that use two ways, namely electronic and printed ways, combined to support one another. Hybrid libraries are often also called mixed libraries, which are mixed electronic collections with non-electronic collections.

Until now, the City Government (Pemkot) of Bandung has 394 Smart City applications. All applications are built with the aim to provide jobs as well as public services. However, the technology that is generated, does not necessarily create a print collection that has become lost and forgotten by today's generation. Therefore this design, orbiting the hybrid library, is a merger between digital libraries and libraries with a ratio of 60: 40. Consideration of the library that focuses on digital libraries is carried out by this design goal, which is to accommodate the means of reading the Bandung community by presenting design facilities that different from the others.
