ABSTRACT

Exhibitionism is a mental disorder characterized by a tendency to show indecent things, such as showing genitals on the opposite sex. Exhibitionism often occurs in public spaces or commonly called street harassment. Most victims of exhibitionism are women. In this case it proves that men can show power over themselves through their genitals. By using the phenomenology method as a qualitative research method and using interviews as a data collection technique, the researcher then obtained the results of the study that fear was the dominant feeling felt by the three selected informants. They feel that the space in the Telkom University public space is getting narrower especially for women.
