

## **Abstract**

But that doesn't mean for any information we have people will be interested on spreading it. This study aims to produce a Retweetabilityprediction program for a tweet and observe the performance and accuracy of machine learning Support Vector Machine by using user-based features as a model. The k-fold cross validation method is used after preprocessing the data. The research has succeeded in producing an algorithm that can predict the retweetability of a tweet with f1-score 66,05%.**
