The method used in this research is Roland Barthes' semiotic analysis method to find elements of feminism in the Nurbaya musical series. mise en sceneand narrative elements in the Nurbaya Musical Series film, which starts from Episodes 1 to 6 and is supported by literature studies and interviews to obtain information related to research. As for the results of this study, feminism in Minangkabau culture occurs because of the patriarchal system that triggers the dominance of power over women.
