

ABSTRACT

INTERIOR DESIGN OF MUAFFA MEDIKA PRATAMA CLINIC IN TASIKMALAYA WITH PSYCHOLOGICAL APPROACH

Clinic are a level 1 Health Service Facility, making it the first place of health services visited by the community. The level of community need for clinical facilities is quite large. According to the results of questionnaire observations conducted, around 76% of people visit clinic facilities more often and around 84% of people prefer public clinics as the first health facilities visited when sick. West Java Province is the province with the highest number of clinics in Indonesia, one of which is Tasikmalaya Regency. Tasikmalaya has a total of 58 clinics consisting of 56 pratama clinics, 2 utama clinics and 16 clinics that provide inpatient facilities. Muaffa Medika General Clinic is one of the Pratama type clinics located in Manonjaya District, Tasikmalaya Regency. This clinic consists of 2 floors and provides several medical service coverage consisting of outpatient, inpatient, emergency, laboratory and pharmaceutical installation services. The psychological approach is applied to the design as an effort to accelerate healing and reduce stress levels in room users, especially patients by creating a comfortable environment in each clinic room. The application of this design is expected to be able to provide comfort and trigger positive energy for patients to be optimistic about recovering from their illness.
