Textiles is one of the largest industries in the world that continues to grow and produces a lot of small and large waste that is not reprocessed, one of which is denim. In the city of Bandung, denim fabric can produce approximately 1,000 tons of waste per day. Teddy Collection is a denim convection that does not reprocess fabric left over from its production, and produces 30-40 kg of long waste a day. In previous research, there were already people who processed denim waste using the raft-making technique, but only using tapestry and macrame techniques, in this research we will use the crochet technique. The research methods that will be used are exploration, interviews, literature study and observation. The final result of this research is denim waste that has been processed using crochet techniques as a substitute for thread and applied to fashion clothing.
