ABSTRACT

Illegal imports have become a global concern due to their negative impact on the economy, environment and society as a whole. The main focus of this research is to identify the factors that encourage individuals and organizations to undertake illegal imports, including economic benefits, regulatory vulnerabilities, and market demand. Apart from that, this research will also explore the social, economic and environmental impacts of illegal imports and the efforts made to overcome them. In this research the author used sample data taken in 2013 - 2022, all data on inflation, exchange rates, gross domestic product, human development index, volume of illegal imports in Indonesia. This research method uses the Ordinary Least Square analysis method. It is hoped that the results of this research will provide better insight into the complexity of the illegal import problem and provide a basis for developing more effective policies in addressing this challenge globally.
