ABSTRACT

The Satu Sehat application is a platform developed by the Ministry of Health as an initiative to provide health-related information and meet the public's growing need for digital health awareness in Indonesia. The aim of this study is to examine how significantly the use of the Satu Sehat application influences the fulfillment of health information needs among residents of West Java province. This research employs a quantitative approach using a survey method. The sampling technique applied is nonprobability sampling with purposive sampling, resulting in 196 respondents who are active users of the Satu Sehat application. The collected data were processed using SPSS version 27.The data analysis includes descriptive analysis, normality test, heteroscedasticity test, simple regression analysis, correlation coefficient, and coefficient of determination. Based on the partial hypothesis testing (t-test), the study indicates that the Satu Sehat application has a significant impact on the fulfillment of public health information needs in West Java, showing a relatively high level of influence. Based on these findings, it is recommended that the Ministry of Health continue to evaluate and improve the Satu Sehat application so that it can better meet public needs.
