ABSTRACT

Abstract: Yogyakarta continues to grow as a tourism destination, marked by an increasing number of visitors and rising activity at Yogyakarta International Airport (YIA). However, this growth has not been matched by sufficient accommodation facilities, particularly transit hotels near the Airport. The distance to the city center and the need for temporary rest areas for passengers highlight the urgency of such a facility. This transit hotel is designed with a spatial psychology approach to ensure comfort and tranquility. The theme Serenity Space aims to create a calming atmosphere, while the Rechargeability concept focuses on effective energy recovery in a short time. This project is expected to provide both functional and emotional support for passengers, while contributing to the development of the Airport area and Yogyakarta's tourism sector.
